Oyster Creek Tour – Beginner Paddle within the confines of Oyster Creek

 Mouse Harbor Tour – Intermediate Paddle approximately 8 Miles Lunch Stop

 Pamlico Point Loop – Advanced Paddle partially on Neuse River somewhat exposed - approximately 10 miles - Lunch Stop

Directions:

Take Route 55 to Bayboro Turn Left on Rt. 304 (Just After Courthouse)

Go 14.6 Miles on 304 – Cross Bridge into Hobucken – Turn Left on Rt. 1230 Lowland Road. Go 4.2 Miles on 1230 and turn right on Rt. 1234 Horne Road

Go 0.8 Miles on 1234 and turn right on Rt. 1235 Oyster Creek Road
